Institutional Repository is a new service managed in the Library to preserve and share the scholarly, creative, and administrative assets of KAZGUU University.

Institutional Repository site is intended for scholarly work authored by KAZGUU University faculty, graduate and undergraduate students. Currently, the focus is on larger collections of material, such as electronic theses and dissertations from the graduate school, undergraduate honors theses, and conference posters. With collections as a foundation for the repository, we are in the process of expanding to individual submissions by faculty, especially of articles submitted to peer-reviewed journals that faculty members wish to make freely accessible. Institutional Repository site is also a platform for hosting open access online journals based in the University KAZGUU community. The site serves as a showcase for scholarly work being created in our academic community, and to provide that scholarly work to audiences.
